President's Update:

- Chapter Operation report deadline is typically 4/1; Pam will pass along all the notes and folders she has. A suggestion was made to use the prior year's report as a reference point for the current year's report.

Fall 2010 Education Session: The educational session will open at 8:00 with registration and breakfast. Vendors have been asked to start setting up at 7:00 a.m. The membership will be highly encouraged to visit the vendors throughout the day and not just during the morning break.

Friday morning it is likely Dennis Pedersen will not be present to speak, but Aileen will likely be able to start earlier than anticipated.

Melynda has filler slideshows to present during breaks.

<u>Upcoming Meeting Dates:</u> 2011 meeting dates are set for May 26th and 27th, and September 15th and 16th.

Ben Widenboom; Laura Darst, Jeanne Scott. The group has been advised to avoid "fluff" topics as other chapters have experienced a drop in attendance from "fluff" topics. The House is now under Republican control and the Democrats now only have a slim majority in the Senate. The chances of repealing the bill are slim due to the President's ability to veto and the Democrats still controlling the Senate. However, expect to see a repeal bill introduced early next year anyway, as Republicans will want to force Democrats to vote for keeping the Healthcare bill setting the Democrats up for another interesting election in 2012. A serious effort by Republicans to repeal the existing bill is going to require that they put together a compelling "alternative" plan and it

will take some time for them to put a plan together.

All in all, it is going to be a very interesting couple of years as I am sure we will see all types of "political moves" as each party tries to move their agenda forward. Hopefully, some good will come out of all of this for healthcare!
